Dear Mr. Hsu:

By letter dated June 12, 2009, Doosan HF Controls Corporation submitted an affidavit dated June 12, 2009, executed by Ivan Chow, requesting that the information contained in the following documents be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390 (titles have been changed from those listed in the affidavit to reflect the titles appearing on the documents):

Nonproprietary copies of these documents have been placed in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Public Document Room and added to the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Public Electronic Reading Room.

The affidavit stated that the submitted information should be considered exempt from mandatory public disclosure for the following reasons:

- Its use by a competitor would reduce his expenditure of resources and improve his competitive position in the design, manufacture, installation, assurance of quality, or licensing a digital based I&C [instrumentation and control] system.
- It reveals cost or price information, production capacities, budget levels, or commercial strategies of Doosan HFC, its customers or suppliers.
- It reveals aspects of past, present or future Doosan HFC or customer funded development plans and programs of potential commercial value to Doosan HFC.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.

Therefore, the versions of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, we may send copies of this information to our consultants working in this area. We will, of course, ensure that the consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). You also should understand that the NRC may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
