
The University of Notre Dame wishes to amend its Broad Scope License to reflect changes in the protocol for receipt of radioactive material.

In license application date February 28, 2007, Appendix G, Section E, Radioisotope Procurement, the final sentence should be changed to: Responsible investigators who anticipate receiving samples from suppliers, or any other shipments of radioactive materials for which there will be no purchase order, must inform Risk Management and Safety as soon as they are aware of it, and instruct the shipper to send the article to the University Warehouse at 100 Mason Service Center, Central Receiving North.

The fee for this amendment application is exempt by Section 170.11(4) of 10 CFR 170.




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
