Section 552, and request copies of any and all files and records related to St. Albans Naval Hospital and/or St. Albans Veterans Administration Hospital, and/or St. Albans Veterans Administration Extended Care Center (hereinafter collectively referred to as "St. Albans Hospital") located at 179-00 Linden Blvd, Jamaica, NY 11425 (Queens County), New York, as follows:

Copies of any and all files and records relating to this facility at any time, including the 1964 radiation leak and contamination incident at St. Albans Hospital complex. Files and records include, but are not limited to, investigation reports, inspection reports, clean up reports, interview notes, test data and/or any citation(s) issued by any State or Federal regulatory authority. This request includes copies of questionnaires, audio recordings, photographs, videos, diagrams, drawings, sampling and testing reports, radiation dose reconstructions, engineering calculations, memoranda, and correspondence, to the extent such documents exist. This request specifically includes documentation relating to strontium-90 and/or radiation levels at the facility at any time, including exposure levels prior to, during and following the 1964 incident.
