By application dated June 3, 2008, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval of a construction authorization.

The question in the enclosed request for additional information (RAI) was e-mailed on June 16, 2009, and discussed in a telephone call with Mr. Steve Gomberg, et al., of your staff on June 23, 2009. This is RAI Set 1 of Safety Evaluation Report, Volume 4, Chapter 2.5.6, Plans for Conduct of Normal Activities Including Maintenance, Surveillance, and Periodic Testing. During the discussion, DOE agreed to provide a response to this RAI by August 26, 2009.
