
Due to the following facts great care should be given to making this decision. Firstly depleted uranium (hexafluoride) is a waste product from plants like the proposed facility and is notoriously hard to manage, becoming more radioactive over time. Second AREVA has a history of very poor business practices like dumping contaminated wastes into the English Channel and contaminating seawater all the way to the Arctic Circle. It is vital that any thought towards granting this proposed facility permission to exist be taken slowly, carefully and with great thought.
