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Subject: Request for Extension of 30-Day Comment Period NRC Enforcement Policy Revision Notice of Availability of Revised Draft Supplements and Request for Comments (Federal Register Notice 74FR27191, dated June 8, 2009)

Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) is submitting this letter to request that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) consider extending the 30-day comment period concerning the request for comments on the NRC Enforcement Policy Revision recently published in the Federal Register (i.e., 74FR27191, dated June 8, 2009).

On September 15, 2008, the NRC published a notice of availability and request for comments in the Federal Register (i.e., 73FR53286) on draft proposed changes to its Enforcement Policy. A corrected proposed revision to the Enforcement Policy was subsequently published in the Federal Register on October 16, 2008 (i.e., 73FR61442). The public comment period for the revised Enforcement Policy ended on November 14, 2008. The NRC is now soliciting comments from interested parties including public interest groups, States, members of the public and the regulated industry (*i.e.*, reactor and materials licensees, vendors, and contractors), on additional proposed changes to Section 6.0, *"Supplements – Violation Examples,"* of the proposed revised Enforcement Policy. The comment period related to these proposed changes ends on July 8, 2009.

Exelon appreciates the opportunity to review the proposed revisions to the Enforcement Policy, but believes additional time is needed to effectively evaluate the proposed changes and provide comments. Therefore, Exelon is requesting that the NRC consider extending the comment period until July 29, 2009.

By letter dated June 18, 2009, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) requested that the NRC extend the comment period until July 29, 2009. Exelon fully supports NEI's request.
