

FOREWORD

This Plan is Appendix 8 to Annex B of the North Carolina Emergency Operations Plan (EOP). As a stand alone portion of the EOP this Plan was developed using the guidelines and information in NUREG-0654, Rev 1, Criteria for Preparation and Evaluation of Radiological Emergency Response Plans and Preparedness in Support of Nuclear Power Plants, dated November 1980. Appropriate criteria items contained in NUREG-0654 are addressed in the plan.

The plan is a mutually supportive emergency response document. It identifies resources and responsibilities of all response organizations and establishes a design by which they will be meshed to protect the population that could be adversely affected by an accident at one of the commercial Nuclear Power facilities affecting North Carolina.

This plan consists of a State section (PART 1) with necessary Annexes and Appendixes containing additional information and details which are applicable to all applications of the plan. Part 1 establishes State procedures and stipulates how the State integrates its emergency response activity with other major response jurisdictions and organizations. Similarly, the County section (PART-2, Sections 1 – 4) consists of County plans that stipulate how the individual counties around the specified nuclear power facility integrate their emergency response activity with other major response jurisdictions and organizations for response to the nuclear power facility in their jurisdiction. For thoroughness, this plan is designed around the major functions identified in NUREG-0654.

The combination of the State section with the appropriate County section and applicable state and local emergency procedures and guides will constitute an integrated emergency response plan for an event at any of the commercial Nuclear Power facilities. For these reasons separate implementing procedures are not deemed necessary.
