Licensee has a medium sized nuclear medicine program conducting routine imaging and diagnostic procedures. The licensee has three techs who perform approximately 12 procedures per day. This clinic receives its radiopharmaceuticals in the form of unit doses from Cardinal Health. Performance Observations The inspector toured the facilities and interviewed authorized users and staff members encountered. Each appeared knowledgeable in radiation safety and isotope handling techniques. Licensee personnel demonstrated package receipt procedures for the inspector. Staff members also demonstrated proper rad waste handling practices. Independent surveys by the inspector did not detect any abnormal reading and were within the expected range. The inspector observed members of the nuclear medicine staff perform injections of radiopharmaceuticals. Techniques employed by the staff demonstrated good handling practices as well as adequate knowledge of radiation safety. During the course of the inspection, no abnormalities were
