
Dear Mr. Heacock:

By letter dated June 25, 2009, (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML091750997), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an acceptance review regarding the relief request Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) submitted in association with the Millstone Power Station, Unit No. 3 third 10-year inservice inspection program interval.
