Based on our review of the final status survey documentation submitted in support of the request, we have determined that you have satisfactorily demonstrated that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination."

The NRC performed an environmental assessment for this action and noticed it in the Federal Register. The Notice of Availability of Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact for this action was published on June 22, 2009, in the Federal Register, Volume 74, Page Number 29520.
