Discussion:			
Prior to the call, NRC staff emailed the following two questions to PG&E:			
1. Changes to section 17.1 eliminate the description of the Site Vice President position; yet, in section 17.2.3, under the			
discussion on the composition of the NSOC, it is stated that the NSOC will normally include the Site VP. If the Site Vice			
President will have a role in reviewing HBPP activities, even if he's part of an independent review committee, shouldn't this			
function be mentioned in Section 17.1? Or, would it be more appropriate for someone equivalent to the Site VP position from HBPP to be on the NSOC?			
HBFF to be on the NSOC:			
2. Section 17.2.4, under PSRC composition, was edited to delete "and quality control" as a member of plant staff. Why was QC deleted?			
During the phone call, PG&E stated that leaving the Site VP in section 17.2.3 (question 1 above) was indeed an oversight, and that they would rectify the oversight via their corrective action program. PG&E stated that the NSOC does include the HB power plant manager, the highest ranking person onsite. NRC staff requested that PG&E send their SAP notification to the NRC.			
PG&E, in response to question 2 above, explained that the quality control (QC) was consciously deleted to allow QC independence and to keep QC out of the plant review process, which is similar to their SAFSTOR program, and also similar to the Diablo Canyon Power Plant QA plan.
