Westinghouse Electric Company LLC (WEC) hereby provides the final status report for the Nuclear Criticality Safety Improvement Project (NCSIP). NCSIP was completed in accordance with Safety Condition S-3 of SNM-1107. Attachment A presents the NCSIP Key Performance Indicator (KPI), as of June 30, 2009. In addition, for compliance with Safety Condition S-1 of SNM-1107, Westinghouse did not issue any new or revised Criticality Safety related validation reports in the last calendar quarter.

Based upon the completion of the NCSIP, WEC requests a SNM-1107 license amendment to remove the associated conditions related to the NCSIP. Safety Condition S-1 should have reference to the WEC July 18, 2007 supplement removed. Safety Conditions S-3 and S-4 should also be removed.

Please note that the batch process systems listed below have not yet been fully upgraded to the NCSIP requirements. These systems are out of service and contain insignificant amount of Special Nuclear Material. These systems will be returned to service only with implementation of Criticality Safety Evaluations (CSEs), which are fully compliant with Section 6.1.4.2(6) of the license application.

- Cylinder wash
- Erbia powder handling
- Warm caustic processing
- LLRW soft media blasting
- Conversion sorting hood

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
