PURPOSE: To inform the residents and interested stakeholders in the area of the US Ecology Disposal Facility (EDF) in Grand View, Idaho of (1) Westinghouse Electric Company's request to amend the Hematite license (NRC ADAMS No. ML0914800710) to permit disposal of low-activity radioactive materials from the Hematite Decommissioning Project at the EDF and that US Ecology be exempt from the requirements of 10 CFR 30.3 and 10 CFR 70.3 which require entities which possess byproduct and special nuclear material, respectively to possess an NRC license and (2) the (NRC) process which allows interested parties to provide comments on a proposed action and/or request a hearing.
