Enclosed is Amendment No. 35 to your NRC Material License No. 24-18628-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Your letter dated April 28, 2009, requested the expansion of Dr. Patrick O'Keefe's authorization to include the oral administration of sodium iodide iodine-131 in quantities greater than 33 millicuries. However, the 313(AUT) forms that accompanied this letter were incomplete, in that pages 5 and 6 of the forms were missing. Therefore, I was unable to approve of this request.

If you wish to pursue this request, please provide a complete application for Dr. O'Keefe that includes the missing 313 (AUT) form pages, address it to my attention and reference it as "additional information to control no. 318067." We will then continue our review.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system.

Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability. You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

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The enclosed document contains sensitive security-related information.
When separated from this cover letter this letter is uncontrolled.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
