Levy County Environmental Review

NRC and USACE

- Status of 2nd round of RAIs.
 - PEF indicated that information will be provided within 30 days, with the exception of floodplains compensation, as discussed below
 - Floodplains storage loss / floodplains compensation
PEF plans to provide a systematic analysis with respect to the SCA by January 2010. To meet more immediate obligations for the DEIS, PEF is committed to providing a bounding analysis by August 14. PEF calculations to determine if compensation is actually necessary will not be available until early 2010.
 - Figures
PEF will provide the figures being requested through RAI General - 1.
 - Cumulative LNP / CREC discharges
Information regarding the cumulative impact of the Levy discharge to the existing CREC discharge will be provided by PEF through RAI 5.3.2.1-~~21~~.
 - Wetlands mitigation plan
USACE had a meeting with PEF last week. PEF's response will discuss the mitigation plan and how the plan will incorporate a watershed approach to comply with the Mitigation Rule under RAI USACE-12.
 - Additional terrestrial resources assessments – PEF will address RAI USACE-13.
- Status of LEDPA analysis
Information regarding LEDPA has been reviewed by PEF's legal team and NRC can expect to receive the document by June 30.
- Discussions on supplements to 1st round of RAIs (PEF will provide this information as soon as possible).
 - Cumulative Chemical Discharges – Baseline information on the current chemical discharge components and concentrations from CREC Units 1-5 is necessary in order to determine the cumulative effects of the LNP (RAI 9.4.2-1).
 - Groundwater – Additional figures are needed to address H-G. Tech memo TM338884-TMEM-074 and additional figures will be docketed. If the figures are docketed separate from the Tech memo, PEF should provide a discussion on the specific modeling that was done in detail.
 - Socioeconomics/EJ – PEF will provide the following in order to further clarify June 12 responses to supplement RAIs.
 - With reference to previously-provided 044 Attachment 4.4.2-1B, PEF will submit a summary of construction employment amounts in 2000 and 2005 in the same format as the 1990 summary.
 - To explain the sales tax exemptions assumed in the ER, PEF will send technical memos that describe how Florida statutes apply to sale of

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electricity. The tech memo will cite Sec 212.02(19) as the basis for the reason why electricity for sale is considered to be a tangible personal property item in Florida.

- PEF will provide a reasonable estimation of sales taxes associated with the operations phase.
- PEF will explain how, in estimating property tax associated with operations phase, they developed a value for the LNP property and how they reduced the value to account for pollution control equipment. PEF will provide an estimate of the initial property value that would be used for property tax assessment and an estimate of how the value would decline over time.
