In case you have not heard, New Jersey will become an Agreement State the end of September 2009. In preparation, we are reviewing all licenses that have locations of use and/or storage in New Jersey. Your license falls into that category. Here are a few things I will need from you...

1. You have a choice to make - choose from the two paragraphs below:

- You have reviewed your current license and have determined that you need to maintain both an NRC license and a State of New Jersey license. You therefore request that your existing NRC license be amended to remove authorization for use of material in the State of New Jersey and authorize work activities only in Non-Agreement States. In addition, you request that the NRC issue a new license for work activities only in the State of New Jersey. You understand that your new license will then be transferred to the State of New Jersey in conjunction with the effective date of the Agreement between the NRC and the State of New Jersey. You further understand that you will be assessed annual fees to maintain both the NRC and State of New Jersey licenses.
- You have reviewed your current license and no longer find it necessary for authorization to conduct licensed activities in NRC-regulated states, and therefore request that your existing NRC license be amended to authorize the use of material only in the State of New Jersey. You request that this be effective on the date the Agreement between the NRC and the State of New Jersey is signed. You understand that upon the effective date of the Agreement between the NRC and the State of New Jersey, you will be licensed by the State of New Jersey to conduct work at temporary job sites in the State and as such, must file a NRC Form 241 (reciprocity) prior to performing any work in NRC jurisdictions (Non-Agreement States) or in areas of Exclusive Federal Jurisdiction within an Agreement State.
