Dear Mr. Barginere:

Under the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) - Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), executed on February 20, 2007, states that, in writing, DHS is to provide the NRC comments concerning the potential vulnerabilities of the location of a proposed facility to terrorist attack. The MOU implements Section 657, "Department of Homeland Security" of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (PL-109-58).

On April 17, 2008, the NRC accepted the Progress Energy Shearon Harris combined license (COL) application for Units 2 and 3 for docketing. A DHS visit to the Progress Energy Shearon Harris site was performed the week of June 16, 2008. On September 8, 2008, DHS completed its review and provided the new reactor Consultation Report for the Progress Energy Shearon Harris site to the NRC.

The Safeguards Information (SGI) portion of the new reactor Consultation Report is enclosed as Enclosure 1. The consultation report is provided as "for information only." Progress Energy is not required to respond to this correspondence. Further, Enclosure 1 does not include Appendix A, Homeland Infrastructure Threat and Risk Analysis Center Threat Assessment Annex In Support of New Reactor Consultation.
