The Licensing Branch Chief, Eric Benner, had scheduled a conference call with Mr. Cole, Manager Licensing & Safety Analysis, Babcock & Wilcox Nuclear Operations group, Inc. (B&W NOG) to discuss the following points:				
(1) NRC staff needs a written justification that articulates the need for a closed meeting planned for August 5, 2009. The staff also needs to receive the presentation materials at least one week before the meeting.				
(2) NRC staff needs to have a basis for the B&W NOG's proposed schedule of January 2010 for responding to the March 2009 RAIs. Staff usually considers terminating a review if no responses are received within 6 months.				
(3) NRC staff needs to have a written confirmation that the package is not being used until technical issues are satisfactorily resolved.				
Mr. Cole said that, the items being shipped include Confidential Restricted Data (CRD) because of their geometry while the UNC-2600 SAR in itself is not classified. Mr. Cole agreed to (i) provide a written response to points (1) and (3) raised by the Licensing Branch Chief and (ii) will discuss point (2) during next month's meeting to work towards an alignment of a proposed "path forward" at the August 5 meeting.
