Dear Mr. Gribbin:

This is in reference to your letter dated May 28, 2009 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-14966-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. 10 CFR 35.50 requires the radiation safety officer to have training in radiation safety, regulatory issues and emergency procedures for the types of use authorized by the license. Your current license authorizes any diagnostic study or therapy procedure permitted by 10 CFR 35.300, yet the attestation in the Form 313A (RSO) submitted indicates that Dr. Friedenberg has not received training for all uses of 10 CFR 35.300. Please submit an attestation that Dr. Friedenberg has completed the required training. If Dr. Friedenberg has not, we recommend that you withdraw your request and reapply at a later date when sufficient training has been obtained.
2. In item 3 of NRC Form 313A (AUD), submitted for Dr. Friedenberg, the "no" confirmation box was checked for eluting generator systems. NRC regulations require that all the training listed in item 3 be completed. Please submit a Form 313A (AUD) indicating that Dr. Friedenberg has completed the required training. If Dr. Friedenberg has not, we recommend that you withdraw your request and reapply at a later date when sufficient training has been obtained.

Current NRC regulations and guidance are included on the NRC's website at www.nrc.gov; select **Nuclear Materials; Medical, Academic, and Industrial Uses of Nuclear Material**; then **Regulations, Guidance, and Communications**. You may also obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-866-512-1800.
