This letter is in reference to the Nine Mile Point 3 Nuclear Power Plant environmental review, as referenced in the May 21, 2009 Federal Register notice, page 23897.

I am the Mayor of the City of Fulton, New York, located approximately fifteen miles from the proposed Nine Mile Point 3 nuclear power plant. Enclosed please find a resolution of support for the construction of this new plant, passed by the Fulton Common Council on June 16, 2009.

On behalf of both myself and the Fulton Common Council, I would like to reiterate the points made in the resolution. It is our belief that nuclear power is a safe form of power generation that does not negatively impact on the environment by releasing greenhouse gases.

Whereas, a new nuclear power plant will increase our county's tax base, providing millions of dollars each year in additional property tax revenues.


