Dear Mr. Couture:

In your e-mail to me dated July 17, 2009, you requested an extension of the period for responding to our request for additional information (RAI) sent in a letter dated July 8, 2009. The RAIs resulted from our review of your 2009 application to revise the physical security plan.

Your e-mail informed me that the August 8, 2009, due date could not be met for the following reasons:

1. You need clarification from the reviewer in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR) and Region II staff.
2. Another Westinghouse employee, who is in orientation, should nonetheless, listen to the NRC/Region/NSIR discussion.

I also realize that you were at the Westinghouse Hematite facility recently. This and other pressing business with NRC has precluded you from addressing the RAIs.

This letter grants Westinghouse an extension from August 8, 2009, to August 21, 2009.
