Mark, I'm Doug Huyck, Branch Chief in Reactor Security Rulemaking and Licensing, NSIR,USNRC. I'm responding to your previous question on RG 5.7.

Your Question:

Hello, I've been told that a new Regulatory Guide 5.7 is due out soon. My company is the distributor for General Electric search equipment and I would like to see a copy of the draft regulation to see if our equipment meets the new guide line. We supply more Explosives Detectors to the industry than any other supplier and I'm a bit surprised that a new guide line is being issued without determining if the existing equipment on the market can meet this regiment. To my knowledge no one has ask General Electric if the equipment being manufactured today can meet a new standard with an updated Regulatory Guide 5.7. This is my second request. The first one was sent on 7/17

Response:

This RG 5.7 is currently under review and revision based on the new part 73 rule. Prior to publishing this RG, the RG will be made available to the public for comments and the staff will conduct a public meeting to discuss comments. The RG should be ready for public comment later this year.
