- data recoveries appear to be very good;
- will need to look at Environmental audit responses and FSAR Section 2.3.3 and ER Section 6.4 descriptions of the three meteorological towers onsite to determine whether discussion of "downriver" and "back-up" is sufficient;
- the format of some ASCII-character data files is difficult to read - not sure if this is a file structure / formatting issue or whether it has to do with the application used to read files of this type.
