Enclosed is an application (XSNM3607) recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), dated July 22, 2009, from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), for the export of highly-enriched uranium in the form of small metal samples to Canada to be used in a nuclear forensics exercise to be conducted in support of the International Technical Working Group on Nuclear Smuggling. The uranium will be used exclusively for the sample analysis exercise under a contract between the Canadian Government and DOE and will be destroyed as a result of the exercise.

Assurances from Canada that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.
