Dear Lt. General Wilson:

I am responding to your letter dated July 8, 2009, which forwarded for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review and approval security and environmental monitoring plans pertaining to depleted uranium from the M101 Spotting Round. Two generic plans were provided titled "Physical Security Plan for Depleted Uranium from the M101 Spotting Round" and "Environmental Radiation Monitoring Plan for Depleted Uranium From the M101 Spotting Round." Additionally, two site-specific Environmental Radiation Monitoring Plans were provided for Schofield Barracks and the Pohakuloa Training Area.

We have completed our preliminary review of the submitted plans, and the plans have been accepted for formal review. Please note that the complete technical review may identify omissions in the submittal information or technical issues that require additional information.

Based on our acceptance review and projection of current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review by the end of January 2010. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.
