This letter forwards Submission 5 of the North Anna Combined License Application (COLA). The submission includes Revision 2 to Part 3, Environmental Report (ER).

This ER revision incorporates updated information on the use of adjoining property that was previously submitted to the NRC as proprietary information in Submission 2 on December 19, 2008, and originally submitted on September 19, 2008 (Serial No. NA3-08-108) in response to supplemental environmental information needs requested. In addition, the ER revision provides updated information on the affected transmission corridor and a proposed large component transport route; presents results and agreed-upon mitigation actions from conducting an in-stream flow incremental methodology (IFIM) study; and describes cumulative impacts associated with changes to the site and facilities to support the existing units. There are also some editorial and clarifying changes included in this submission. A summary of changes is provided in the ER's Revision Summary.

This updated information also necessitates certain changes to the FSAR, such as those associated with the IFIM study mitigation actions, which will be provided in a subsequent submission.

The enclosure is a CD containing Submission 5. Revision 2 to Part 3, ER, does not include any proprietary information. Dominion has successfully performed the preflight checks and examined the PDF file contained on the CD to ensure conformance with NRC guidelines related to electronic submittals, Guidance for Electronic Submissions to the NRC, Revision 4, October 2008. The PDF file meets NRC criteria.




