Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter dated March 28, 2008, Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) submitted an application for combined licenses (COLs) for two Westinghouse AP1000 advanced passive pressurized water reactors, designated Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP) Units 3 and 4, at the VEGP site in Burke County, Georgia. Part 7 (Departures, Exemptions, and Variances) of the VEGP Units 3 and 4 COL Application contains the VEGP Departure Report. The VEGP Departure Report describes VEGP-specific departures from the AP1000 Design Control Document (DCD).

SNC letter AR-08-1408, dated September 11, 2008, submitted a six-month update to the VEGP Departure Report, and did not identify any additions, deletions, or changes.


