

**MATERIALS LICENSE**

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

CONDITIONS

10. Licensed material may be used or stored only at the licensee's facilities located at:

  - B. Cardiac Diagnostic Center North, 3521 Silverside Road, Concord Plaza-Quillen Building, Suite 1-A, Wilmington, Delaware;
  - C. 1100 Forrest Avenue, Dover, Delaware;
  - D. Cardiac Diagnostic Center – Middletown, 114 Sandhill Drive, Suite 203, Middletown, Delaware;
  - E. Cardiac Diagnostic Center – Millville, 609 Atlantic Avenue, Suite C, Millville, Delaware;
  - F. 16704 King's Highway, Lewes, Delaware; and
  - G. 802 North DuPont Highway, Milford, Delaware.
11. The Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) for this license is Barry Denenberg, M.D.

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12. Licensed material is only authorized for use by, or under the supervision of:
- A. Individuals permitted to work as an authorized user in accordance with 10 CFR 35.13 and 35.14.

Additionally, this license condition does not limit the licensee's ability to make changes to the radiation protection program as provided for in 10 CFR 35.26. The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
