The Turkey Point COL Application contained only the following:

- State of Florida Radiological Emergency Management Plan (Annex A to State Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan) (July 2008) – w/o Appendices, and
- State of Florida Radiological Emergency Management Plan, Annex A, Appendix II, Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant Site Plan.

The region noted that in order for the offsite emergency planning information to be sufficiently complete in content and depth such that correct docketing of all materials used and a detailed review can be performed, copies of the following current official plans, procedures, and documents should be submitted by FP&L, through the NRC as part of their official COL application:

- State of Florida Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan,
- Florida Department of Health, Bureau of Radiation Control standard operating procedures relating to Turkey Point,
- Miami-Dade County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan,
- Miami-Dade County Radiological Emergency Preparedness Plan (MDREPP),
- Miami-Dade Emergency Operations Center standard operating procedures listed in the MDREPP,
- Monroe County Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan,
- Monroe County Radiological Emergency Preparedness Plan and Standard Operating Procedures,
- Florida Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement
- The Southern Mutual Radiation Assistance Plan,
- Florida Emergency Alert System Operational Plan, and
- Other mutual aid plans, memoranda of understanding, and letters of agreement between the state or counties and volunteer agencies (e.g. American Red Cross) or other organizations which are intended to be part of the overall response organization.
