Mr. Rydalch,
Please see the .pdf of the license amendment w/Notice of Violation. The original will go out in the mail today. If you have any questions once you've read through the documentation, please let me know.

I reviewed the information in the docket file and while the inspector noted that he reviewed the shipping papers, when the source was shipped back to INC on 11/7/08, there was not any supporting documentation in the file. Please send me either the last leak test result or the shipping documentation and we can subsequently remove the storage/use location at Yellowstone from the license, if you would like to pursue that.

Please recognize that by License Condition 18, once you have completed the implementation of the ICs at the new facility, then you must notify the NRC at the Washington, DC address, in writing within 25 days after the IC requirements have been completed.

Please note also, if the T&R Official changes, then the new T&R Official will have to be approved in the same manner as you were approved. I have attached a summary of the Q&As in which the first question addresses the T&R Official (with and without unescorted access.)
