The NRC requested that PPL provide additional information to support the review of the Bell Bend COLA in Reference 1 on July 10, 2009. The responses to the questions identified in RAI No. 30 were requested to be provided within 30 calendar days. Based on vendor review and input, the time required to complete the necessary work will exceed this timeframe and PPL requests an extension until December 11, 2009.
