Enclosed is the final report for the Three Mile Island (TMI) Generating Station Radiological Emergency Preparedness Exercise that was held on April 14, 2009.

No deficiencies and three Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCAs) were identified as a result of this exercise; one of the ARCAs was successfully re-demonstrated during the exercise. Two ARCAs from a previous exercise were successfully demonstrated at this exercise; one additional previous ARCA was closed administratively. Three new planning issues were identified; seven planning issues from a previous exercise were successfully demonstrated, and three planning issues from a previous exercise remain unresolved.

Based on the results of the exercise, the offsite radiological emergency response plans and preparedness for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the affected local jurisdictions, site-specific to TMI, are adequate to protect the public health and safety in the event of a radiological emergency at the site.
