Introductions

Levy County Environmental Review

- USACE Project Needs and Clarifications
 - The following issues will be addressed after issuance of the DEIS but before issuance of the FEIS
 - Map/drawing which shows the boundaries of the watersheds described in the RAI response, along with the location of all of the boundaries of the proposed project elements (i.e., plant site, transmission lines, blowdown corridor, mitigation sites, including the location of the two mitigation banks) to show how potential project impacts are located in relation to potential mitigation areas within specific watersheds. Exhibit 1-2 from the 13 January 2009 edition of the mitigation plan could be used with additional overlays of the watersheds as defined by PEF, and mitigation sites, as identified by PEF.
 - Information as to which impacts go to which mitigation area.
 - Information and rationale on how watersheds and boundaries were chosen or identified.
 - Response states that no "government-approved" watershed plan exists for the vicinity of the LNP Units 1& 2. The mitigation rule does not limit a watershed plan to those "approved" by a governmental entity (see definition of "watershed plan" in section 332.2 of the rule). Is it PEF's position that there are no watershed plans for either the Withlacoochee or Waccasassa watersheds specific to the watersheds for which the LNP plant is located? What about the watersheds in which other project elements are located, specifically transmission lines, etc. in the Tampa, Hillsborough, Upper Coastal watersheds (as identified by PEF). Identification of the watershed plans is tied to the location of all of the project's impacts. Corps remains concerned regarding out-of-watershed mitigation, and what steps to take next, if out-of-watershed mitigation is proposed.
