This is in follow up to our telephone conversation from today, August 18, regarding the two subject Schlumberger Technology Corporation's licenses that were transferred to the State of Pennsylvania. License No. 42-29291-01 was created specifically for transfer to the State, under timely renewal. During the interim, I renewed NRC's license for Schlumberger which is 42-00090-03, so that the license reflects the latest commitments and tie-down conditions for Schlumberger. I subsequently issued a duplicate corrected copy to 42-00090-03 to capture the facility drawing in Bradford, PA as a tie-down condition and forwarded the corrected copy of the license to Region 1 for subsequent transmittal to the State of Pennsylvania. However, I should have made the corrections and incorporated the tie-down conditions based on the renewal to the new license that was specifically issued for the State of Pennsylvania, 42-29291-01.

Therefore, please update License No. 42-29291-01 with the tie-down conditions and commitments made on License No. 42-00090-03 to reflect the licensee's latest commitments based on their license renewal. Please delete any further reference to 42-00090-03, since this License No. remains an active license issued by the NRC to Schlumberger Technology Corporation.
