During the review process, we identified one change that we'd like to propose to the toll milling license amendment to clarify the allowable range of shipments. The proposed revision to the license condition is below. The change would be using "must" instead of "can" in the second sentence.

The licensee may receive and process up to 365 toll shipments of loaded ion exchange (ix) resin at the Smith Ranch central processing plant per calendar year. The tolled ix resin must be generated at NRC licensed uranium recovery facilities located in the State of Wyoming. The activities will be performed in accordance with the submittals dated June 19, 2008, and October 1, 2008.

The licensee may receive and process up to 365 toll shipments of loaded ion exchange (ix) resin at the Smith Ranch central processing plant per calendar year. The tolled ix resin can be generated at NRC licensed uranium recovery facilities located in the State of Wyoming. The activities will be performed in accordance with the submittals dated June 19, 2008, and October 1, 2008.
