SUBJECT: LEVY COUNTY NUCLEAR POWER PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION – REVISED REVIEW SCHEDULE

Dear Mr. Scarola:

By letter dated July 28, 2008 (ADAMS Accession No. ML082260277), Progress Energy Florida, Inc. (PEF) submitted its application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a combined license (COL) for two AP1000 advanced passive pressurized water reactors pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 52. By letter dated February 18, 2009 (ML090350045), the NRC staff transmitted the Levy County Nuclear Power Plant (LNP) Units 1 and 2 COL Application (COLA) review schedule. For reasons described in more detail below, the NRC staff has reassessed the safety review schedule for the LNP Units 1 and 2 COLA. The revised safety review schedule is included in this letter and supports the issuance of a final safety evaluation report (FSER) in July 2011. Milestones for the remaining phases of the safety review are provided in Table 1. This letter does not include any update to the environmental review schedule.

As previously discussed with your staff, the material properties and characteristics of the LNP site require a more complicated review in the geotechnical and structural engineering areas. As stated in our letter dated February 18, 2009, the LNP Units 1 and 2 COLA review schedule assumes that responses to Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) will be complete and provide sufficient information to address the NRC staff's concerns. In addition, our schedule assumes that RAI responses will be submitted within 30 days of receipt of RAIs related to areas that involve LNP specific information. Although some of your responses to geotechnical and structural engineering RAIs have been received within 30 days, many responses have been submitted later than the assumed 30 day time period. The revised safety review schedule in this letter accounts for the actual submittal dates of your RAI responses.
