By letter dated April 20, 2009, Pacific Gas and Electric Company submitted a request to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), in accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations 72.56, "Application for amendment of license." The application requested that Materials License SNM-2514 be amended to allow for the relocation of the Humboldt Bay independent spent fuel storage installation quality assurance (QA) requirements from the Diablo Canyon Power Plant Part 50 QA plan to the Humboldt Bay Power Plant Part 50 QA plan.

The NRC has approved the requested amendment. The amended license supersedes, in its entirety, Materials License SNM-2514, Amendment No. 1, dated August 6, 2008. Changes made to the enclosed Materials License are indicated by vertical lines in the right margin.
