On July 17, 2009, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved the transfer of the above captioned license to the Department of Energy (DOE). Over the last month, the present holder of the license, Foster Wheeler Environmental Corporation (FWENC) and FWENC's subcontractor, Tetra Tech EC, Inc. (Tetra Tech), have been working with DOE and its representatives to prepare to transfer the necessary documents and government property associated with the ISF project. DOE has informed us that Patricia Bergeson has been authorized by DOE to accept receipt of these documents. This letter confirms that Ms. Bergeson has received and now possesses all documents for the ISF project that both parties believe are necessary to affect this license transfer, which includes among other things the following:

1. As of the date and time noted below, Tetra Tech has transferred possession of all government property and necessary original records associated with the ISF project, including:

Fire resistant safes and other cabinets; and

All existing original and approved project documents, except as noted in paragraph 2 of this letter. The foregoing project documents include among other things the following: administrative documents, correspondence, project management documents, submittals, procurement, approved calculations, approved drawings, reference materials, quality control documents, Environmental, Safety & Health documents, and training documents.

(The documents, records, and property described above in this letter are hereinafter collectively referred to as "the ISF records".)

2. FWENC and Tetra Tech have not transferred attorney-client privilege and certain sensitive internal financial information related documents since none of this information is required as part of the official project file. Tetra Tech has marked all attorney-client privilege and sensitive internal financial information related documents on the database provided with this document transfer as "Removed." A copy of that database is included with the transferred records.





As DOE is aware, certain ISF records, including Medical Data Sheets in Section 9.3 of the ISF project documentation, contain social security numbers and other sensitive information, and likely fall within the scope of the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended. As such, DOE, through its authorized representatives, has assumed the responsibility to exercise the necessary protection and care of that information to prevent unauthorized disclosure.
4. On the date of this letter, Tetra Tech has sent by U.S. mail, in accordance with applicable regulations, all safeguards documents associated with the ISF project to DOE's designated individual, Randy Elwood. As countersigned below, DOE or its authorized representative confirms that this person is authorized to receive ISF Project safeguards documents under 10 CFR Part 73.
5. DOE agrees to maintain the ISF records in accordance with applicable regulations. DOE also acknowledges that from the date of this letter forward, FWENC and Tetra Tech have no further responsibilities pertaining to maintaining the ISF records.


