Behram:

As we discussed, attached is an update to Table 1.4-1 of the ER. We have confirmed that Campbell County Planning does not require any permits or approvals. The rural portions of the County include extractive industry as a planned use. We also have confirmed that the septic system program in Campbell County is administered by the WDEQ; some Counties in Wyoming have authority for septic systems under the WDEQ program but Campbell is not among them.

As we discussed this morning, the RAI responses remaining, which cover the topical areas (as listed in the RAI) of Surface Waters/Wetlands, Surface Water Quality, Site Area Groundwater Use, Groundwater Quality, Groundwater Impacts, Groundwater Consumption, Ecology, Public and Occupational Health, Public and Occupational Health Impacts, Waste Management Impacts, and Land Use are complete and ready to submit by Thursday with two exceptions. The surface water and wetlands question (TR section 2.8.5.2) is similar to a request from the ACOE for the wetlands determination, which we submitted last week. Our consultant is preparing the ER RAI response. I hope to have it by Thursday to include in our submittal. The other item concerns wellfield spills (ER Section 4.4.2.3.2); our consultant is setting up an unsaturated flow model to address this item and it will be a few weeks before that response is completed.

The new plant location referenced in the Alternatives response is in Section 34. I am attaching a new figure that has been prepared in response to a surface water RAI that shows the new plant location with wellfields, monitor well ring, roads, trunk lines, etc. and includes section lines and contours. The nearest cultural resource to the plant is 48CA964, which is in Section 35. It is considered eligible for listing but will not be affected by any of our proposed facilities. There are two others in Section 35 (48 CA965 and 48CA 966) that were shown at the edge of the monitor well ring in the original application. It appears that 48CA966 may now fall within the latest monitor well ring as shown on the attached figure. Both locations are listed as not eligible.

1. Table 10.1-1 in the TR. What is the latest in the status column; what we have was current as of 9/2007. This table shows what is needed at the state and fed level. What about county permits/approvals?
2. Which RAIs still remain to be addressed and when can we expect to receive them?
3. The site map (original site) and narrative don't always match. The ecology map showing wetlands does not seem to match the T-R-S in the narrative; is the map correct or the narrative?
