This RAI addresses Circulating Water System, as discussed in Section 10.4.5 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 5.

UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to obtain information from its vendors that is required to finalize the response to RAI No. 129, Question 10.04.05-2. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by September 15, 2009.

There are no regulatory commitments identified in this letter.
