The nuclear medicine department was staffed with 1 technologist who performed approximately 70-100 diagnostic cardiac procedures monthly. The licensee received unit doses from a licensed radiopharmacy. The licensee's consultant audited the radiation safety program on a quarterly basis.  This inspection consisted of interviews with licensee personnel, a review of selected records, tour of the nuclear medicine department, and independent measurements. The inspection included observations of dose calibrator QA checks, security of licensed material, package return surveys, and use of personnel monitoring.
