John Fringer called at 11:45 to request a conference call at 12:15 CT TODAY to cover the following.

TE-09 - what are the impacts to birds from fog in the BDTF area?

TE-15 - need a functional assessment of the wetlands now, they do not want to wait for the USACE assessment

TE-17 - what is the nature of fogging and icing around the CT

TE-18 - docket the SmartForm that concluded there have been no electrocution of birds

TE-19 - Need documentation to show that the impact of skyglow from lights at night for 3&4 will be the same as for 1&2

General TE concerns with no TE#: 1) what is the shoreline impact from an extended low lake level condition, and 2) what were the results of relooking for GCW habitat in the BDTF area last fall?

SOC-23 - parts 1&2 were adequately addressed, but the impact of peak # of workers did not encompass 3&4

HYD-11 - second part was not addressed at all: details/calculations for the intake ambient flow. whole last clause was not addressed.

HYD-15 - there was no analysis of modeling results

HYD-18 - need additional details on recirculation impacts on permitting and EIS adequacy

HYD-19 - same question as HYD-18, but focused on low flow conditions

The 1:45 call on HYD will occur after this call.
