# **COMANCHE PEAK 3 & 4 ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT**

## **PRE-ARRIVAL INFORMATION**

The following is some useful information to help you prepare for your visit. Also, maps and directions are provided to get you from DFW airport to Granbury, Glen Rose, and Comanche Peak. Hotel and restaurant information for Granbury and Glen Rose is also included. Lunch will be provided during the audit.

### **Safety and Dress**

Please wear normal work attire for meetings. However, on the first day some of you will be taking tours of the plant site. A few will also be walking through areas of heavy brush and rough terrain. To avoid injury, please wear appropriate attire (i.e., long sleeve shirts, long pants, and sturdy leather shoes, etc.). You will be provided with a set of safety glasses as needed. If you require gloves for your field activities, please bring them along.

### **Identification**

Please bring a government issued photo ID with you.

### **Internet Access**

As a result of cyber security measures taken following 9/11, there will be no site access to the internet or outside networks. Please do not plug your computer into a site connection, as this will disable the connection. Also, your network wireless connection will need to be turned off while at the site. If you need to have access to outside networks, please bring along a cell phone card.

### **Comanche Peak Arrival**

Upon arrival at the Comanche Peak Engineering Building (CPE), enter the front door and proceed to Training Room 1 (Map Location A). There will be signs directing your way.

# DIRECTIONS

## **DFW Airport to Granbury (also see map)**

1. Exit the airport from the **SOUTH** exit;
2. Follow signs to **Hwy. 183 WEST** (Ft. Worth)/**Hwy. 360 SOUTH** (Arlington).
3. Take **Hwy. 360 SOUTH** through Arlington to **I-20 WEST** (Ft. Worth).
4. Take **I-20 WEST** through the southern side of Ft. Worth until you reach **Hwy. 377** (Granbury Exit).
5. Turn South on **Hwy. 377** and drive to Granbury (approx. 30 miles)

## Granbury to Comanche Peak (also see map)

1. To get to the plant, take **Hwy. 377 SOUTH** to **FM144** (also known as Morgan Street) and turn right (the exit ramp for FM144 is just on the other side of the Granbury Lake bridge);
2. Immediately get in the left hand lane. Head **NORTH** one block and turn left at the **FM51 SOUTH** stop light (also known as the Paluxy Highway);
3. Stay on **FM51 SOUTH** for about 9 miles. At this point you will come to a railroad crossing. Just pass this crossing, take the main road which bears to the left (sign says to Glen Rose) which is now **FM56 SOUTH**.
4. Continue about another 4 miles to Comanche Peak, which will be on your left as you approach. There is a stop light at the entrance to the plant. From **FM56** turn left onto the main plant access road.
5. From the main plant access road, turn into the parking lot at the Comanche Peak Engineering Building or CPE (the fifth turn on the right side of the road). The CPE Building is the last building on your right as you approach the Security Access Point. If you get to the Security Access Point, you went too far.

**DFW Airport to Glen Rose**  
(also see map)

1. Exit the airport from the **SOUTH** exit;
2. Follow signs to **Hwy. 183 WEST (Ft. Worth)/ Hwy. 360 SOUTH (Arlington)**;
3. Take **Hwy. 360 SOUTH** through Arlington to **I-20 WEST (Ft. Worth)**;
4. Follow **I-20 West** until you reach **I-35 South (Waco)**;
5. Take **I-35 South** towards Waco;
6. At Alvarado, take **Hwy. 67 West (Cleburne)**;
7. Stay on **Hwy. 67** to Glen Rose. Hotels are past **Hwy. 144** on the right and left sides of **Hwy. 67**.

**Glen Rose to Comanche Peak**  
(also see map)

1. To get to the plant, take **FM 56 North** (right turn) at the light off of **Hwy. 67 West**.
2. Drive about 5 miles and turn right at traffic light onto plant access road.
3. From the main plant access road, turn into the parking lot at the Comanche Peak Engineering Building or CPE (the fifth turn on the right side of the road). The CPE Building is the last building on your right as you approach the Security Access Point. If you get to the Security Access Point, you went too far.

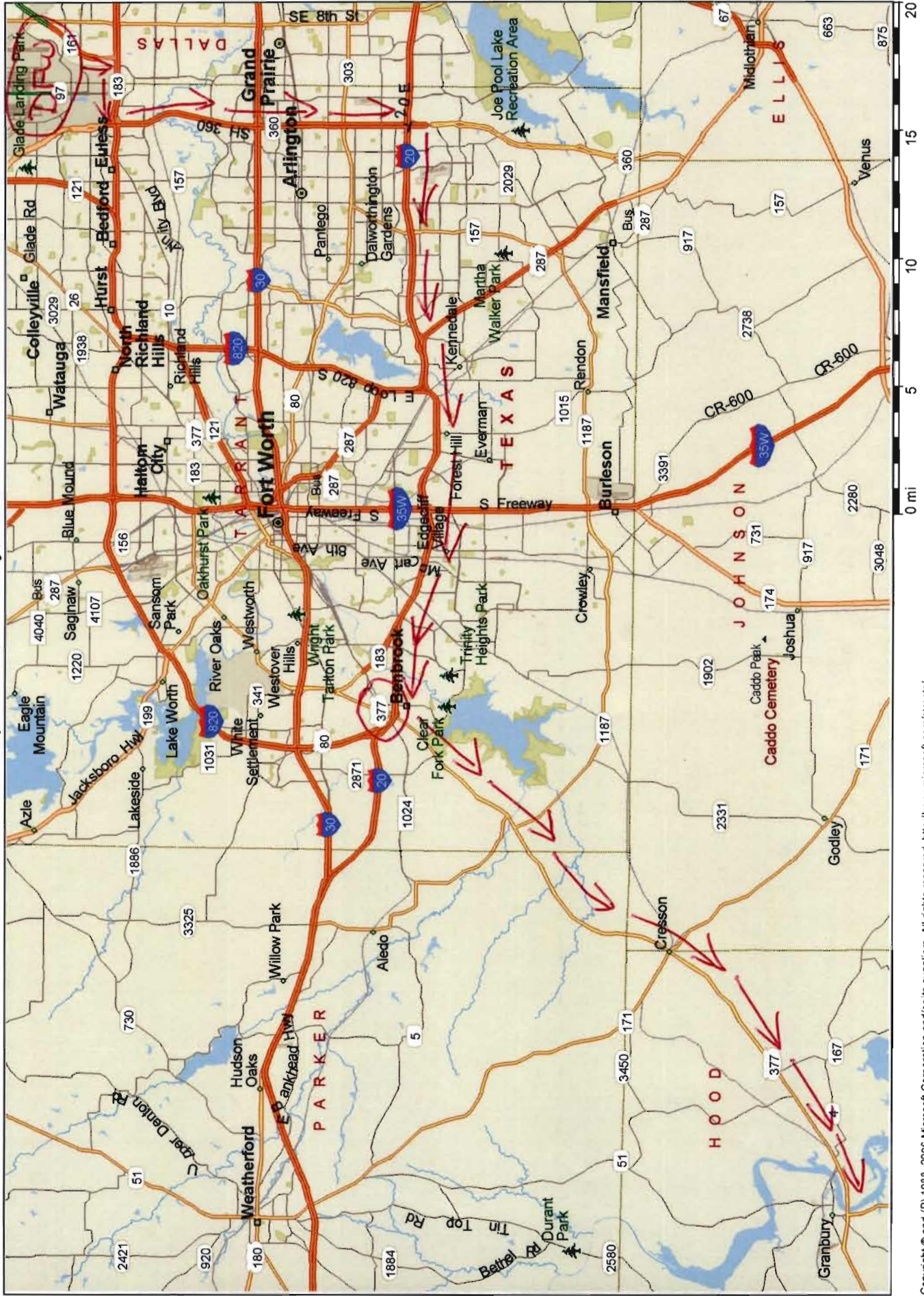

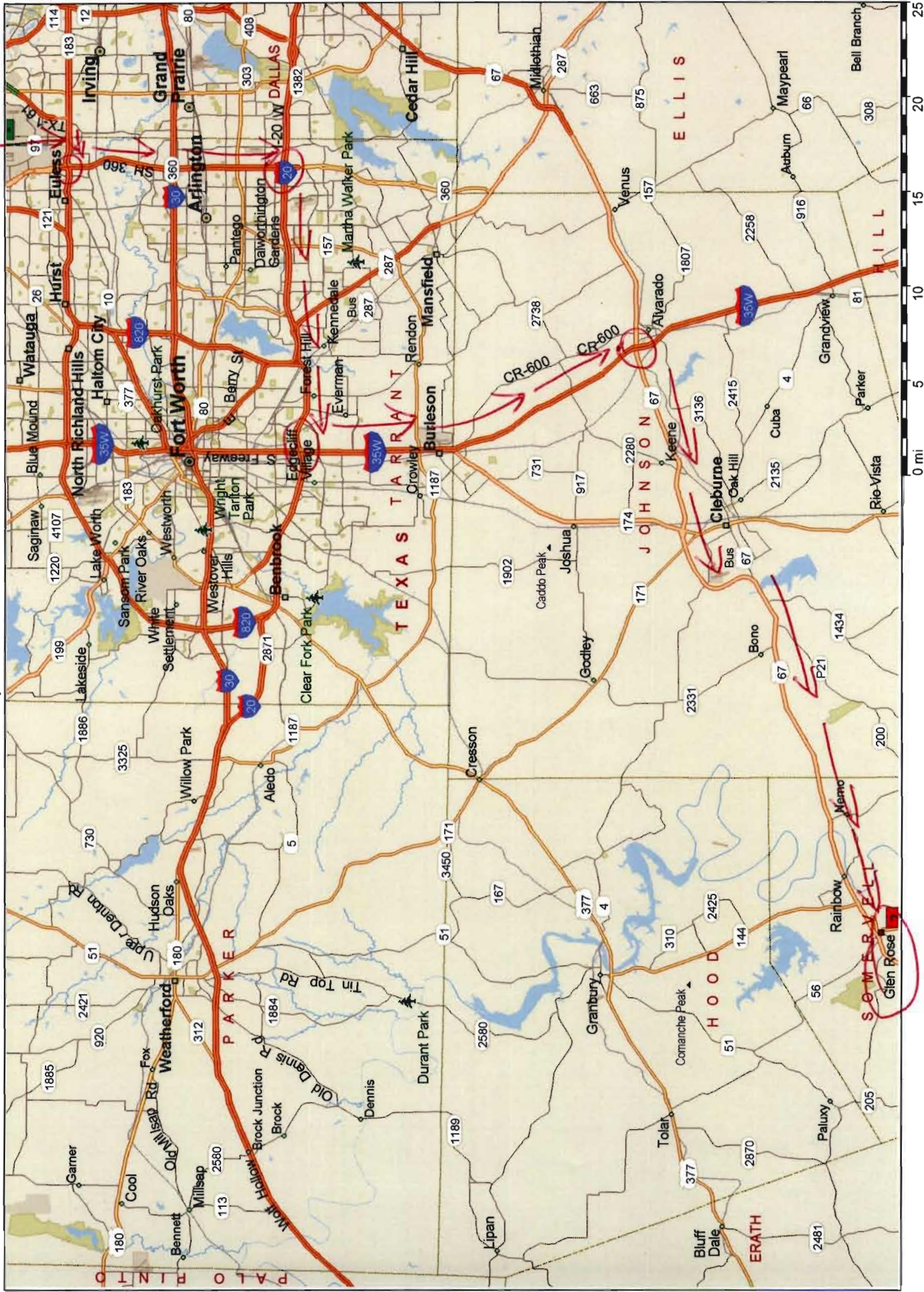

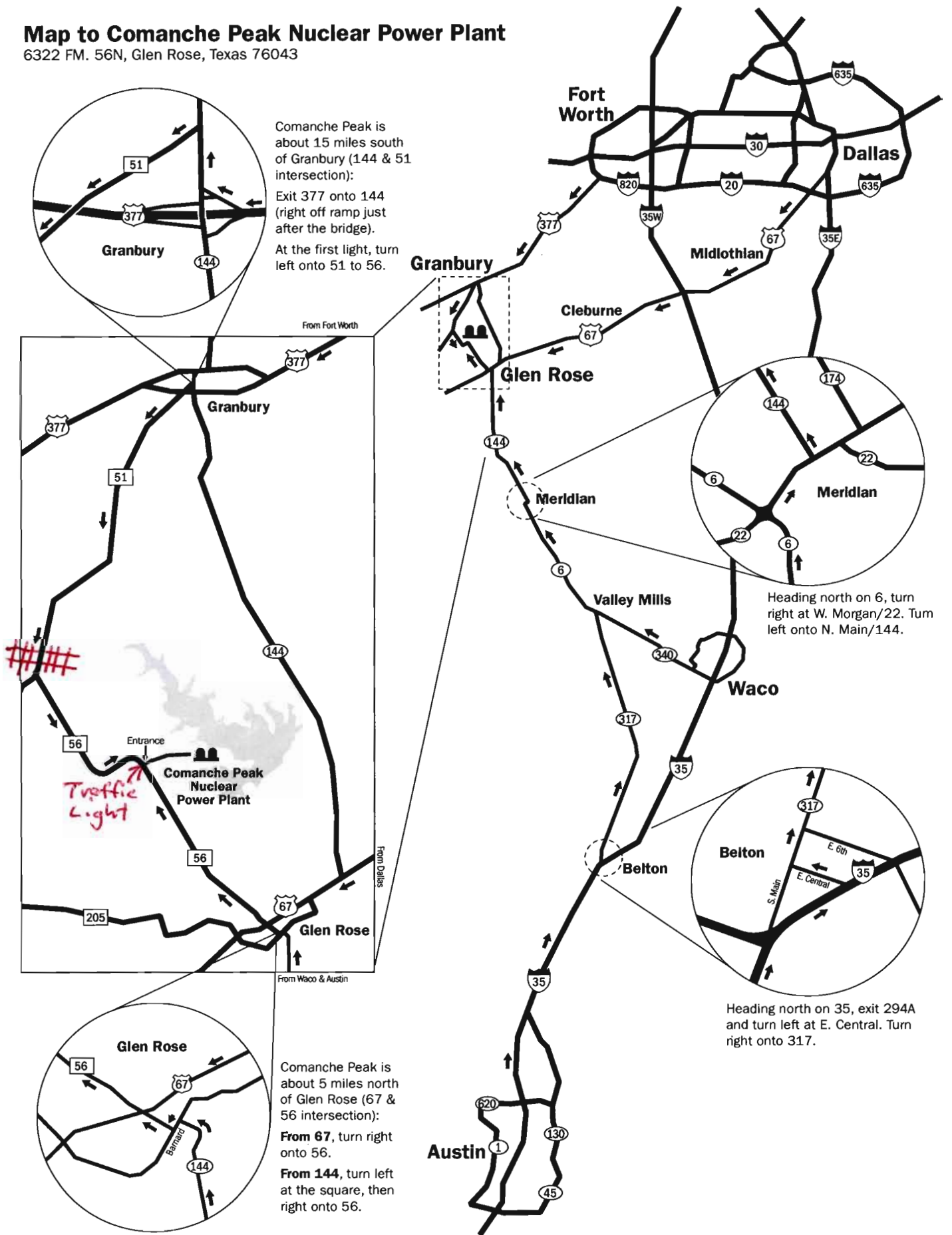

Comanche Peak is about 15 miles south of Granbury (144 & 51 intersection):  
 Exit 377 onto 144 (right off ramp just after the bridge).  
 At the first light, turn left onto 51 to 56.

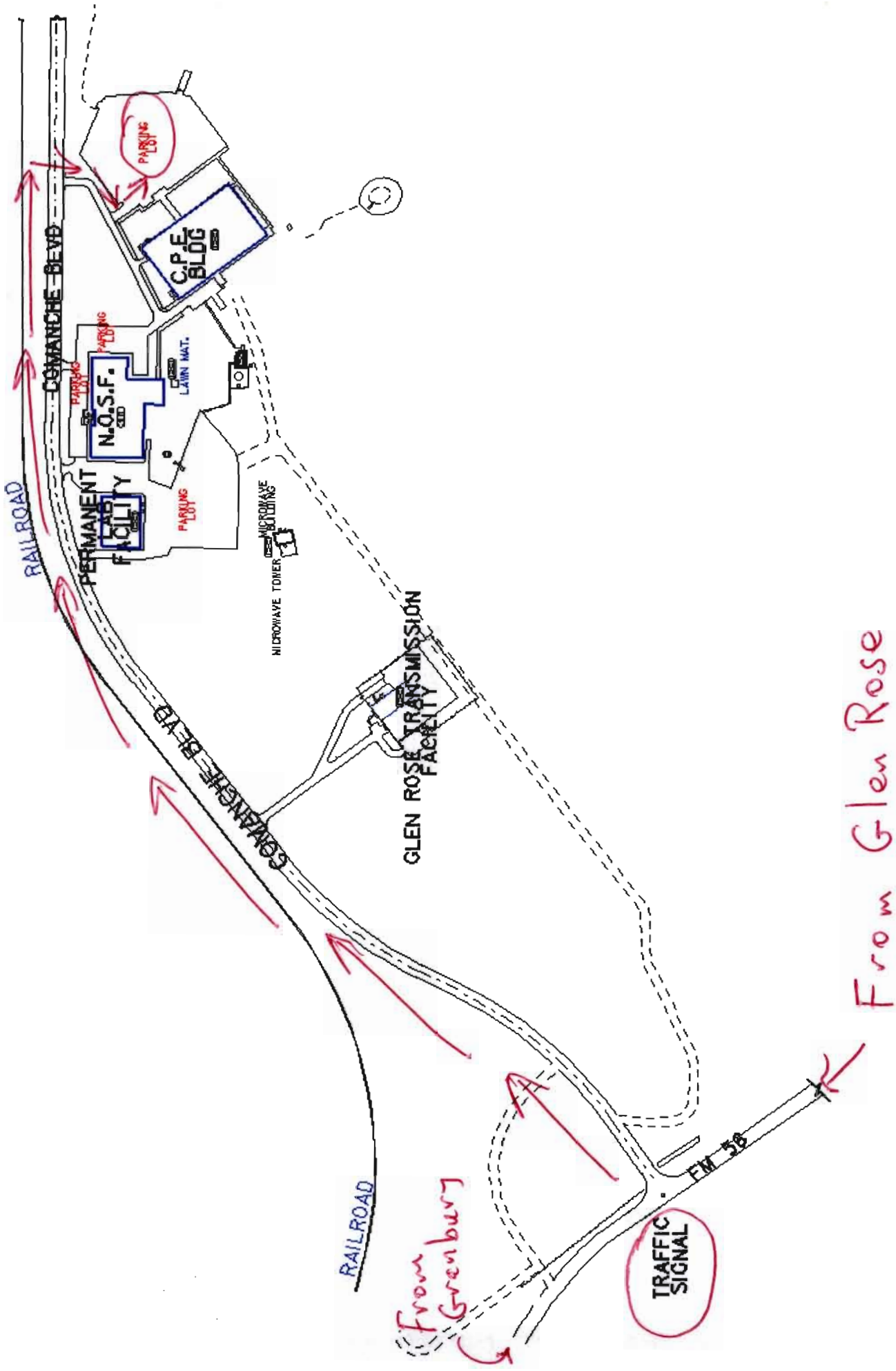
Heading north on 6, turn right at W. Morgary/22. Turn left onto N. Main/144.

Heading north on 35, exit 294A and turn left at E. Central. Turn right onto 317.

Comanche Peak is about 5 miles north of Glen Rose (67 & 56 intersection):  
**From 67**, turn right onto 56.  
**From 144**, turn left at the square, then right onto 56.

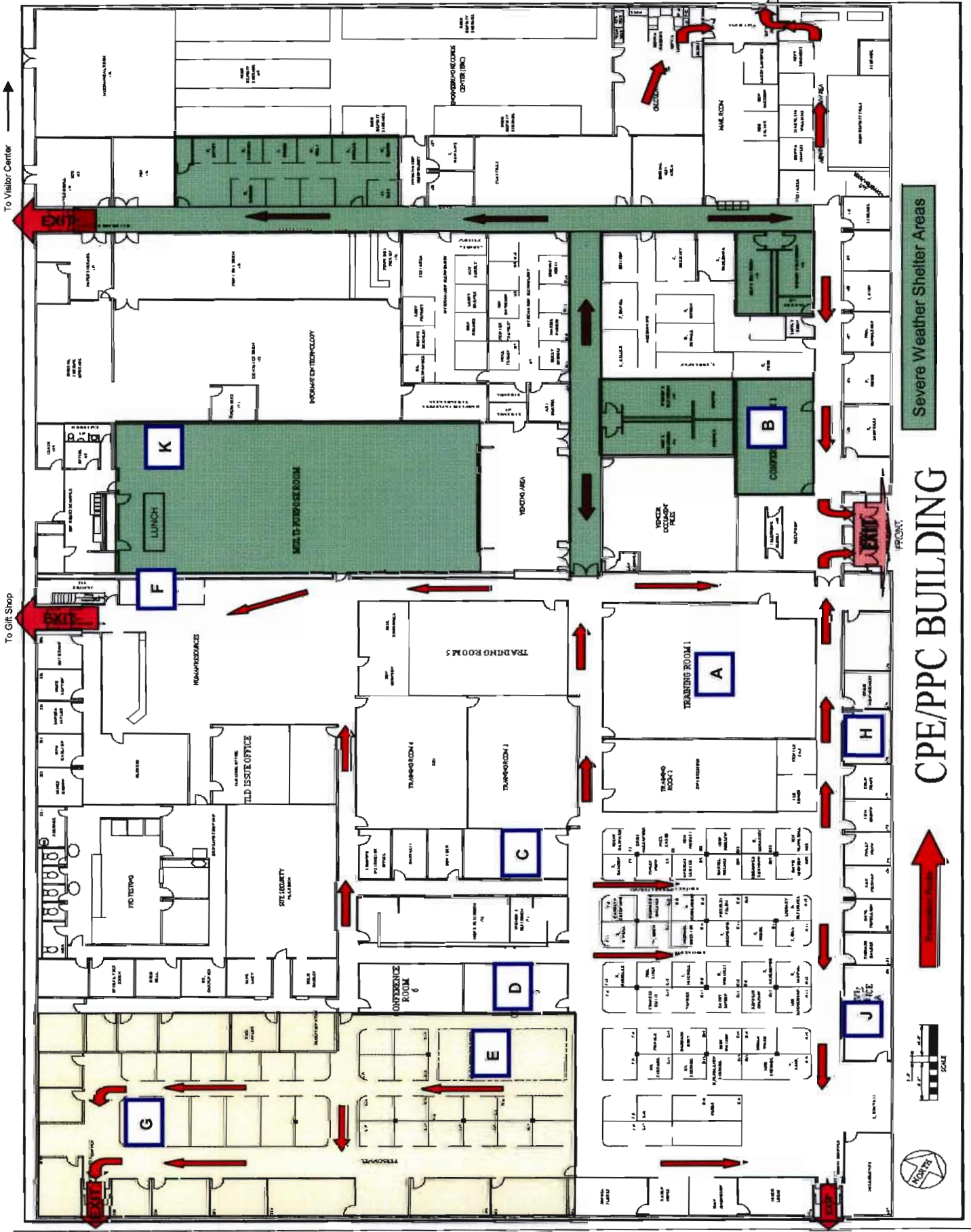
