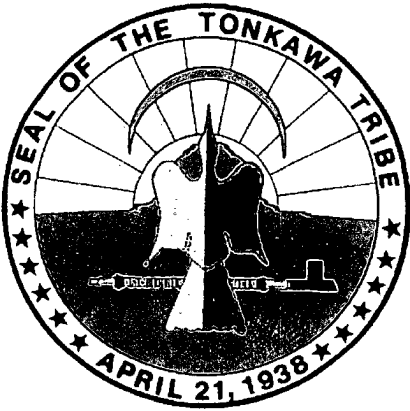

Regarding the proposed construction projects listed we submit the following:


Scoping process for the Environmental Review of the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant, Units 3 and 4 combined license application.
