The purpose of this letter is to respond to the request for additional information (RAI) identified in the NRC e-mail correspondence to UniStar Nuclear Energy, dated August 3, 2009 (Reference 1). This RAI addresses ownership and corporate organizational structure for Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3, as discussed in Part 1 of the CCNPP Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 5.

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As described in RAI No. 133, Question 01-4, UniStar Nuclear Energy has previously provided a description of the anticipated ownership and organization structure for CCNPP Unit 3 following completion of the proposed financial transaction between Constellation Energy Group, Inc. and Electricite de France (SA) (Reference 2). The ownership and organization structure description provided in Reference 2 continues to reflect the best available information regarding the post-transaction ownership and organization structure for CCNPP Unit 3; however, the investment transaction has not yet been concluded and this information is therefore subject to change.


Final details of the proposed financial transaction are expected to become available during October 2009. As a result, UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI No. 133, Question 01-4. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by November 13, 2009.
