

Regulatory Observations

1. Except as specifically noted (e.g., in 10 CFR 50.65), the requirements of 10 CFR 50 apply to safety-related cables only.
2. 10 CFR 50.49, and associated "qualification" requirements, do not apply to cables in mild environments.
3. Submerged safety-related cables need to be evaluated for Operability.
4. If the scope of 10 CFR 50.65 is used for MVC then the substantive requirements of 10 CFR 50.65 apply.

Develop the Problem Statement and Success Path

4. Explore the differences in functional capability of MVC cable types.
