Dear Mr. Williams,

My apologies for not answering your questions sooner. The Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant (CPNPP) Units 3 and 4 COL application was docketed December 2, 2008. The scoping period for the Environmental Report (ER), submitted by the applicant as part of the application, ended on February 17th, 2009. The public was given the opportunity to provide written or e-mailed comments during this period. A scoping meeting was held at the Glen Rose Expo Center in Glen Rose, Texas on January 6th, 2009 to gather comments on the applicants ER. A Scoping Summary Report is available on-line at <http://www.nrc.gov/reactors/new-reactors/col/comanche-peak/documents/nrc-2009.html>. The NRC Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS) is currently in development. It is expected to be made publically available in March 2010. A DEIS comment meeting will be scheduled for that same period and a comment period will be scheduled. The NRC Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) is currently scheduled to be made public in early 2011. A Federal Register Notice of Order, Hearing, and Opportunity to Petition for Leave to Intervene was issued January 30th, 2009. The deadline for receipt of Petitions to Intervene was April 6, 2009. The Atomic Safety Licensing Board (ASLB) admitted two contentions. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has not issued an air permit to my knowledge for this application. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is a cooperating agency on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).
