Dear Mr. Williams:

By application dated June 3, 2008, the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval of a construction authorization for a proposed geologic repository for high-level radioactive waste at Yucca Mountain, NV.

NRC staff has reviewed the information provided in your submittal and determined that additional information is required in order to complete its review. The questions in the enclosed request for additional information (RAI) were e-mailed on August 19, 2009, and discussed in a telephone call with your staff on September 3, 2009. This is RAI Set 1 of Safety Evaluation Report 2.2.1.3.9, Radionuclide Transport in the Saturated Zone. DOE has agreed to provide responses to these RAIs by September 28, 2009. There were no changes made to the RAIs as a result of this phone call.

Timely responses to these RAIs will help NRC meet its 10 CFR Part 2 schedule requirements, and contribute towards meeting its goal of efficient and effective use of staff resources.
