After reviewing our paperwork and talking with some of the previous RSOs here at GWU, it makes the most sense to reduce our limit for SNM to 10 uCi on license 08-00216-22. That line item (Item J) is simply a carryover from when we possessed Pu pacemakers, and now provides us with a safety net if one of the sources happens to appear. There should be no issues with reducing it to 10 uCi as the prior limit, required each individual source to be a maximum of 10 uCi therefore if one turns up we will be in compliance.
