ORDER

The Citizens for Clean Idaho, Inc. ("CCI") have filed a letter seeking an extension of 45 days to respond to the Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing on a proposed amendment to Westinghouse's Hematite license that, if approved, would give Westinghouse permission to transmit decommissioning waste to U.S. Ecology Idaho, Inc., which is not an NRC-licensed facility. See 74 Fed. Reg. 31994 (July 6, 2009). CCI also asks that the Staff hold a new (second) public meeting to explain the proposed amendment.

The NRC Staff has advised CCI, Westinghouse, and the Commission that it will issue a new *Federal Register* Notice extending the Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing until Monday, October 5, 2009. The Staff's action moots CCI's request for an extension of time. To the extent that CCI seeks a further extension of time (*i.e.*, 45 days instead of 30 days) or a second public meeting, those requests are denied.

This Order is issued under my authority in 10 C.F.R. § 2.346(b).
